Enhanced Features include:

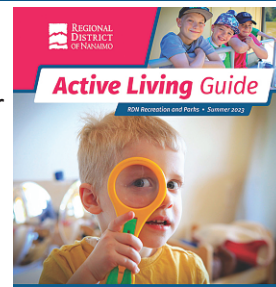

CURBSIDE ORGANICS CART TIPS

Are you taking advantage of the RDN Curbside Organics Program? Using the curbside organics cart is a cost-effective and convenient way to compost your light yard material.

Accepted materials that now go into your organics cart include:

- Light trimmings no larger than 1.5cm (0.5 in) in diameter and no longer than 60cm (2 feet) in length
- Flowers, weeds
Organics material
Lawn clippings
