  - TO IMPROVE COMMUNITY FOR OUR CHILDREN - WE NEED SCHOOL AT SOUTH WELLINGTON. CASSIDY HAS ALREADY LOST THEIRS AND WITH IT THEY LOST PLAYING FIELDS AND RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES.
  - WE NEED TO IMPROVE OUR ROADS FOR CYCLING AND WALKING ALONGSIDE.
  - WE NEED A PLAYGROUND / PARK IN CASSIDY - THERE ARE LOTS OF CHILDREN THERE.
  - WE NEED TO ENCOURAGE COMMUNITY GROUPS AND ASSOCIATIONS - PERHAPS WITH IRON GRANTS TO START UP A COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION - OR TO HELP WITH RENTAL OF FACILITIES.
  - PROVIDE RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR TEENS IN SOUTH WELLINGTON AND CASSIDY AND A BUS ON FRIDAYS AND WEEKENDS TO TOWN (MALLS OR MOVIES AND NANAIMO AQUATIC CENTRE).
  - SKATEBOARD PARK AND OTHER ACTIVITIES FOR OUR YOUTH.
