Septic Maintenance Rebates

In 2019, the Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) is offering rebates in four categories, plus a bonus for SepticSmart workshop participants, to help you maintain your septic system.

- Up to \$200 for installing or replacing a Distribution Box*
- Up to \$300 for installing Risers*
- Up to \$100 for installing an **Effluent Filter***
- \$600 towards the replacement of a Malfunctioning System*



SepticSmart workshop participants qualify for up to \$100 extra towards an eligible claim. See front page of this flyer or visit www.SepticSmart.ca for a listing of 2019 workshops.

*The RDN will rebate 75% of eligible expenses to a maximum amount for Categories 1-3 and the Bonus. Flat rate for Category 4. The maximum rebate is \$600, or \$700 for workshop participants.

Rebates are available until December 13, 2019 or until funds are spent.



Since funds are limited, you may apply for pre-approval to "reserve" funds for eligible work for up to 90 days. New construction and tank pumpouts are not eligible for a rebate.

- When present, a properly functioning **Distribution Box** will maximize the effective lifespan of a drainfield. A tilted or damaged distribution box will distribute the effluent unevenly.
- **Risers** provide surface access to buried components. Risers make future pumping, inspection, and maintenance much easier. If you have risers, you have little to no digging to do hereafter.
- An **Effluent Filter** can prolong the life of your system by keeping solids out of the drainfield.
- Replace a **Malfunctioning System**. Most septic systems last 25-30 years. Eventually, all systems need to be replaced.
