


The Board of the Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) intends to consider a resolution to issue a temporary use permit for the subject property identified on the map below.

# TEMPORARY USE PERMIT

#### **PURPOSE OF PROPOSED PERMIT**

The applicant proposes to temporarily allow a use not permitted under the current Industrial 1 (IN1) Zone of "Regional District of Nanaimo Land Use and Subdivision Bylaw No. 500, 1987". The proposed temporary use is to operate a pharmaceutical grade cannabis recycling, extraction and testing facility within an existing building located at 1451 Island Highway East in Nanoose Bay for a period of three (3) years (see Proposed Site Plan attached).

All persons who believe that the interests of their property are affected by the proposed permit will be afforded an opportunity to be heard at the Board meeting. Written submissions must be received at the RDN office by 4:30 pm, Monday, May 27, 2019, to ensure their inclusion in the public record.
