ADVERSE WEATHER DISRUPTION TO COLLECTION SERVICE

Severe winter weather can result in disruptions to curbside collection by causing unsafe driving conditions, and road access issues for the collection staff. If your material was not collected on a regular collection day, please remove your containers overnight and continue to put missed materials at the curb by 8:00 am the following day until they are collected. This may take several days depending on the severity of the weather.

RDN REBATES

2019 RDN Water Stewardship Rebates are now open! Help conserve and protect our shared resource and save money through rainwater harvesting practices, by increasing the water efficiency of your garden, or by upgrading your well and having your well water tested.



Rainwater Harvesting: Rainwater harvesting is the collection and storage of rainwater directed from roofing and can be used for non-potable applications, like irrigation, or potable use with added treatment. Eligible RDN residents can receive up \$750 for the installation or addition of 1000 imperial gallons of rainwater storage.

Irrigation Upgrades & Soil Improvements: Increase the watering efficiency of pre-existing irrigation systems or upgrade the quality of your garden soil, compost, or mulch. Eligible RDN residents can receive up to \$475 for irrigation upgrades and/or 50% off garden soil improvements up to \$100. Receive a \$100 bonus rebate for completing both irrigation and soil upgrades.

Well Head Upgrades & Well Water Testing: Help protect the quality of our shared groundwater resource by ensuring your well meets current best practices and by having your well water tested. Eligible RDN residents can receive up to \$650 for wellhead upgrades or up to \$500 for the closure of any unused well. 50% off (up to \$150) a full spectrum water quality analysis is available to RDN well-owners.
