## **AUTOMATED CURBSIDE COLLECTION**

Automated curbside collection is coming to the RDN in fall 2020. December 31, 2019, marks the deadline for cart size selection for RDN residential curbside collection customers not serviced by the City of Nanaimo. Select your cart sizes by the December 31, 2019 deadline for a chance to have your 2020 curbside collection fee waived.

If you do not select your preferred cart sizes by the deadline, you will receive a default set which includes a 240-litre recycling cart, 100-litre food waste cart and 100-litre garbage cart.
