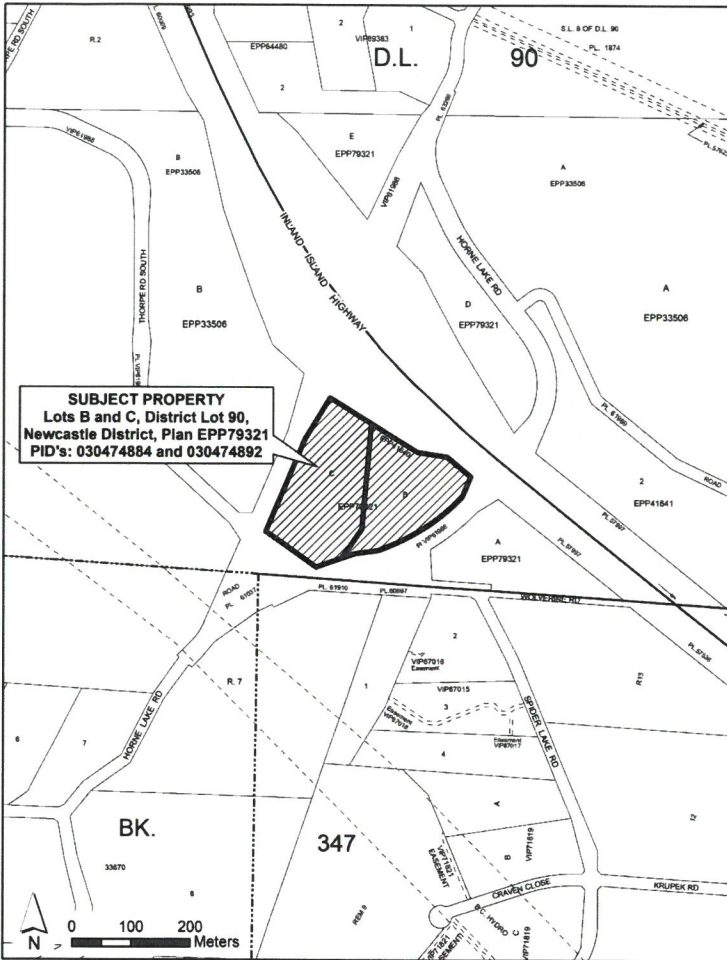


The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) is in receipt of a Zoning Amendment Application for the property shown in the Location Map below.

PURPOSE OF PROPOSED BYLAW

The applicant proposes to rezone the subject property from Rural 6 Zone, Subdivision District 'D' to a Comprehensive Development Zone, under the "Regional District of Nanaimo Land Use and Subdivision Bylaw No. 500, 1987". The new zone would permit an artist studio, convenience store, electric vehicle charging station, emergency services, fast food outlet, gasoline service station, produce market, tourist information booth, restaurant and retail store.
