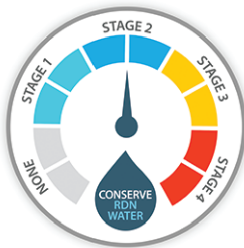

OUTDOOR WATERING RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT

If you are a customer of a municipal, improvement district or RDN water system, please check www.rdn.bc.ca/watering-restriction-map to see which watering restrictions are in place where you live. Outdoor water conservation

helps our region be resilient to drought and maintain water supply for essential needs, fire protection and environmental flows. Veggie gardens and drip irrigation are exempt from restrictions. Although watering restrictions do not apply to private wells, we encourage all water users to practice conservation, as water is a shared resource.

RDN TRANSIT UPDATE

RDN Transit has installed temporary vinyl panels to allow for physical distancing between the operator and passengers on our buses. Beginning June 1, 2020, these safety measures will allow for a return to front door loading and collection of fares on all conventional, community and handyDART services.

This safety measures align with the direction from the Provincial Health Officer.

Other safety measures already implemented will remain in effect including:

- Enhanced cleaning on buses and at RDN Transit facilities;
- Communication to staff and customers about physical distancing procedures; and
- Limiting passenger capacity to support physical distancing.

Face Coverings

The use of face coverings will be encouraged on buses and at bus

stops where physical distancing is not possible. Passengers are responsible for providing their own face covering.

Route 25 Ferry Shuttle

Beginning June 3, 2020, RDN Transit will resume Route 25 Ferry Shuttle to Departure Bay Ferry Terminal and will discontinue service to the Duke Point Ferry Terminal.
