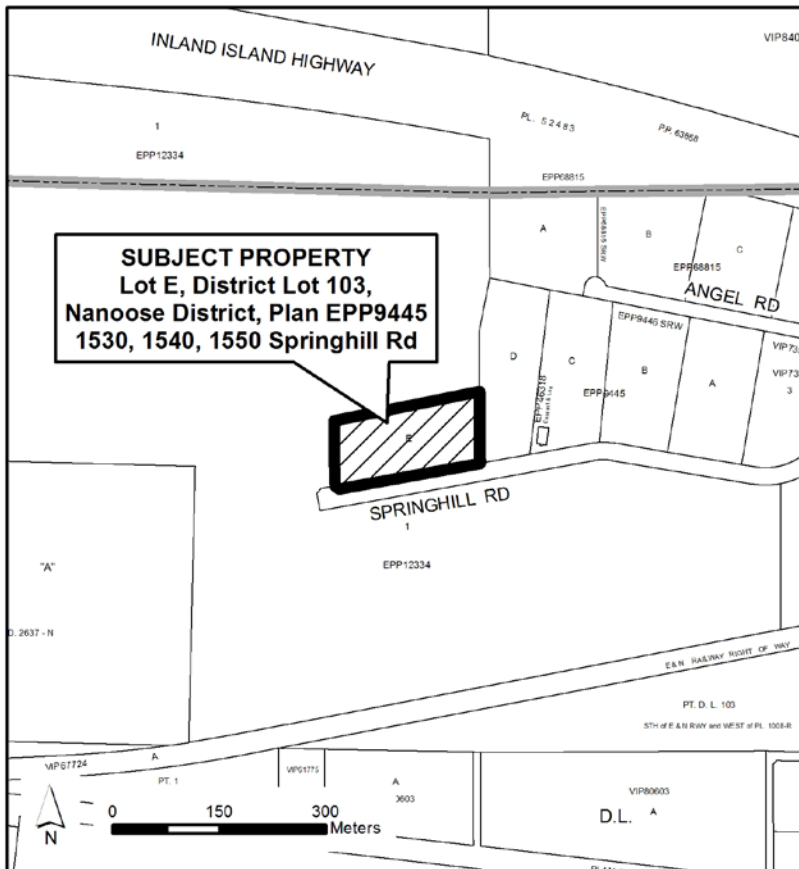


The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) is in receipt of a Zoning Amendment Application for the property shown in the Location Map below.

## NOTICE OF ZONING AMENDMENT APPLICATION

## PURPOSE OF PROPOSED BYLAW

The application proposes to amend "Regional District of Nanaimo Electoral Area 'F' Zoning and Subdivision Bylaw No. 1285, 2002" to change the zone from Industrial 1 (I-1) to Industrial 5 (I-5). The new zone would change the minimum parcel size from 2.0 hectares to 1.0 hectare to facilitate a two-lot subdivision and increase the parcel coverage from 30% on the first hectare and 5% on remaining hectares to 40% parcel coverage.
