ABOUT THE ROLE

The Regional District of Nanaimo is seeking two 2 temporary casual Equipment Operators in the Solid Waste Services department at the Regional Landfill.

The successful candidates will contribute to the effective operation of the Landfill and Transfer Station through the skilled operation of machinery to ensure the safe and efficient operation of the site according to RDN policies and procedures. Specific duties include: the operation of machinery to compact and cover garbage according to the detailed fill plan, building and grading roads on site, screening the contents of loads for restricted or prohibited waste, as well as operating a roll-off bin truck and other duties required in the operation of a busy solid waste landfill site.

QUALIFICATIONS

Qualifications include a High school diploma plus Heavy Equipment Operator Trades Program Certificate, and 2 years prior job-related experience or an equivalent combination of training and experience. Knowledge of landfill and transfer station operations will be considered an asset. Applicants must possess a valid Class 3 BC Driver's License with Air Brake Endorsement, standard first aid course, working knowledge of WHMIS, knowledge of safe work procedures and be in good physical condition to perform the duties of the job. Good judgement with manual dexterity skills is also required.

POSITION DETAILS

This is a temporary casual Union Position for three (3) months, with the possibility of extension based on the operational needs of the department. The (2020) rate of pay is \$29.00 to \$31.22 plus 9% in lieu of benefits including vacation and statutory holidays.

JOB SUMMARY

The Equipment Operator contributes to the effective operation of the Solid Waste Facilities through the skilled operation of machinery to ensure that the Regional Landfill is efficiently utilized. This position supports the Solid Waste department by assisting team members in their duties, as required, to meet service expectations, departmental goals and objectives.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Operates mobile compactor or loader to spread, level, compact and cover loads of municipal solid waste (MSW) in accordance with the Fill Plan.
- Operates track or tired loader to maintain yard waste and construction/demolition stockpiles, mix cover; load and compact scrap metal; load the stationary compactor (CRTS); and load transfer trailers for hauling off site (CRTS).
- Operates bin truck to haul garbage bins from the public drop-off area to the working face for compaction.
- Screens loads of in-coming MSW and monitors stockpiles of yard waste and construction demolition waste for restricted or prohibited materials.
- Disposes of controlled waste in the manner described by policy and procedure manual or as directed by the Supervisor or designate.
- Measures slope ratio and/or grade scale percentage of disposal cell to monitor compaction.
- Maintains roads and ensures that staging areas are level and safe for customers and equipment.
- Deploys and removes tarps over MSW at the working face daily.
- Inspects equipment to ensure that it is in safe operating condition as per pre-start procedures detailed in the manual.
- Cleans and refuels equipment, checks oil levels, leaks or damages at the end of each shift.
- Completes daily equipment condition reports to notify the Mechanic of any damaged or faulty items.
- Assists in the performance of mechanical duties, as required.
- Performs other related duties, as required.
