2020 WATERSHED MONITORING HAS BEGUN



Visit a local waterway this summer and you might see Streamkeepers taking surface water quality samples once a week as part of the RDN's Community Watershed Monitoring Network (CWMN), each August through November. Comprised of 14 volunteer groups from Deep Bay to Cedar, the network includes a total of 68 monitoring sites in 24 watersheds. With the dedication of volunteer stewards and the support of key stakeholders, the program has been tracking the health our streams and guiding stewardship action since 2011!
