BENSON CREEK FALLS REGIONAL PARK

Phase 1 construction for improvements at Benson Creek Falls Regional Park will begin this fall. Contractors will be on site to improve the trail condition in the Benson Creek ravine and to install a hiking bridge across Benson Creek within the Park. A new 40-stall gravel parking lot will also be under construction on Weigles Road, including a connecting trail into the Park.

Park visitors can expect temporary closures of trails and should remain alert to construction activities in and around the Park. For everyone's safety, please obey all signs posted by the contractor.

REBATES

Woodstove Rebates: Replace your old woodstove with a cleaner burning woodstove, heat pump, or other eligible heating appliance this fall and receive up to \$400. Visit www.rdn.bc.ca/woodstove-exchange to find out more for eligibility details and an application form.

Prepare for winter with a home energy assessment: A home energy assessment gives you the information you need to make your home cozier and more energy efficient this winter. RDN rebates are available to Electoral Area Residents who have their house assessed using the EnerGuide Program. Visit www.rdn.bc.ca/home-energy-assessment to find out more for eligibility details and an application form.

Stewardship Seed Funding: This program supports watershed restoration, enhancement and monitoring efforts by not-for-profit environmental stewardship organizations, up to \$5000 per project. Visit www.rdn.bc.ca/stewardship-seed-funding for eligibility details and an application form.

Rainwater Harvesting: Rainwater harvesting is the collection and storage of rainwater directed from roofing and can be used for non-potable applications, like irrigation, or potable use with added treatment. Receive up to \$750 for the installation or addition of 1000 imperial gallons of rainwater storage. Visit www.rdn.bc.ca/rainwater-harvesting for eligibility details and an application form.

Irrigation Upgrades & Soil Improvements: Increase the watering efficiency of pre-existing irrigation systems or upgrade the quality of your garden soil, compost, or mulch. Receive up to \$475 for irrigation upgrades and/or 50% off garden soil improvements up to \$100. Receive a \$100 bonus rebate for completing both irrigation and soil upgrades. Wellhead Upgrades & Well Water Testing: Help protect the quality of our shared groundwater resource by ensuring your well meets current best practices and by having your well water tested. Receive up to \$650 for wellhead upgrades or up to \$500 for the closure of any unused well. 50% off (up to \$150) a full spectrum water quality analysis is available to RDN private well-owners.
