

Stage 1 Watering Restrictions in Effect for Most RDN Water Service Areas

The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) watering restrictions have returned to Stage 1 in most RDN Water Service Areas, including:

RETURN TO STAGE 1 WATERING RESTRICTIONS

- Surfside
- Westerne Heights
- Melrose
- San Pareil
- French Creek (Sandpiper)
- Nanoose Bay Peninsula
- Englishman River (Rivers Edge)

Stage 1 Watering Restrictions - outdoor watering can take place on any day of the week before 7 a.m. and after 7 p.m., and there are no restrictions on washing vehicles or boats, filling pools, or pressure-washing walkways and siding.

Due to some recent water supply challenges, the following RDN Water Service Areas will remain in Stage 4 Watering Restrictions until further notice:

REMAIN IN STAGE 4 WATERING RESTRICTIONS

- Decourcey
- Whiskey Creek

Stage 4 Watering Restrictions - outdoor watering is completely prohibited. In addition, the washing of cars and boats, filling pools, pressure-washing, and new lawn permits is not permitted. When the water supply conditions change, the watering restrictions will be amended, and customers in the Whiskey Creek and Decourcey Water Service Areas will be notified.
