CURBSIDE COLLECTION - CART PLACEMENT

- Leave at least 1m (3ft) of clearance between the carts and any obstacles, such as parked cars, poles, fire hydrants, etc.



- Make sure there is 3m (10ft) of clearance above the carts.

All materials must be placed in the cart with the lid completely closed. Ensure the food waste cart lid is in the locked position. Improperly placed carts, overflowing carts and materials placed outside of the carts will not be collected.

COLLECTION OF USED WASTE COLLECTION CONTAINERS

From November 1 to 30, 2020, RDN residents who choose not to repurpose their used collection containers will be able to get rid of them in one of the two following ways - please note, containers must be CLEAN and FREE OF WASTE:

Option 1 - Drop off at RDN Church Rd Transfer Station (860 Church Road, Parksville) or the RDN Regional Landfill (1105 Cedar Road, Nanaimo) during regular operating hours free of charge - November 1 to 30

Option 2 - Simply set them out for curbside pickup the day AFTER your regularly scheduled collection day - November 16 to 27
