### How Can I Prepare?

- Have an emergency plan and know where you will stay and how you will reunite with your family after an emergency.
- Make sure you have a current grab and go bag.
- Know where your utilities are and how to turn them off.
- Remove important items from basement floors.
- Review your insurance policy.
- Pets are family too - prepare for them as well.

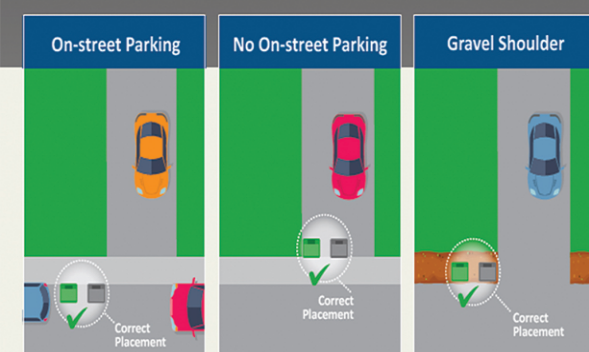

## CURBSIDE COLLECTION

- Leave at least 1m (3ft) of clearance between the carts and any obstacles such as parked cars, poles, fire hydrants, etc.
- Make sure there is 3m (10ft) of clearance above the carts.



- All materials must be placed in the cart with the lid completely closed.
- Ensure the food waste cart lid is in the locked position.
- Improperly placed carts, overflowing carts and materials placed outside of the carts will not be collected.
