



#### **PURPOSE OF THE BYLAWS**

The purpose of Bylaw 1615.04 is to amend the Regional Growth Strategy changing the split land use designation of Lot 2 shown on the map to the left from "Industrial Lands" and "Resource Lands and Open Space" to a split designation of "Industrial Lands" and "Rural Village Area", and changing the land use designation of Lot 3 shown on the bottom of the map from "Resource Lands and Open Space" to "Industrial Lands". The purpose of Bylaw 1620.06 is to amend the Electoral Area A Official Community Plan Section 8.8 Nanaimo Airport and to add objectives and policies to that section. The purpose of Bylaw 500.429 is to rezone Lot 2 shown on the map to the left from Rural 4 (RU4) to a new Airport 1 (AR1) Zone, and to rezone Lots 2, 3 and the East 30 Chains of Section 3 from Agriculture 1 (AG1) to Airport 1 (AR1). If adopted, these Amendment Bylaws will acknowledge current airport use, achieve consistency with the adopted Nanaimo Airport Land Use Plan and support commercial uses complementary to the Airport on part of the land adjacent to the Trans-Canada Highway.

#### **HAVE YOUR SAY**

All persons who consider their interest in property to be affected by the proposed bylaws shall be afforded an opportunity to be heard virtually or by written submission at the Public Hearing. The video feed of the Public Hearing will be live streamed. Anyone who wishes to be heard at the hearing can do so by telephone only. The instructions for how to access the live video feed and speak at the Public Hearing are as follows:
