

PUBLIC HEARING - NANAIMO AIRPORT LAND USE BYLAWS

The RDN is proposing to amend the Regional Growth Strategy (RGS), Electoral Area A Official Community Plan (OCP) and Zoning Bylaw No. 500 for lands owned by the Nanaimo Airport Commission.

The purpose of the proposed amendments is to recognize the existing airport operations and to facilitate future development of the Nanaimo Airport, including commercial uses complementary to the airport on the portion of the property adjacent to the Trans-Canada Highway.

A Public Hearing for the proposed RGS, Electoral Area A OCP and Zoning Bylaw 500 amendments is being held electronically via Zoom on Thursday, April 15, 2021 at 3 p.m. For further information on the project and instructions on attending the virtual Public Hearing please visit: www.getinvolved.rdn.ca/airport or phone 250-390-6761.
