## **WHISKEY CREEK UPDATE -**STAGE 1 WATERING RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT

The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) wishes to notify residents in the Whiskey Creek Water Service Area that the water quality in Crocker Creek has improved adequately since September 2020. With the source water being filtered successfully on-site again, additional water is no longer being trucked into the service area. In this regard, the ban on outdoor watering has been lifted.

Stage 1 Watering Restrictions have been in place since April 1, 2021, with outdoor watering being permitted every night after 7 p.m. and every morning before 7 a.m. (non-peak hours). Please see the table below for further information, or visit rdn.bc.ca/watering-restriction-map.

On May 1, 2021, Stage 2 Watering Restrictions will come into effect, where outdoor watering will be restricted to every other day from 7 to 10 a.m. and 7 to 10 p.m. for a maximum of two hours per day. Further restrictions may be put in place if required.

## **CONSTRUCTION UPDATE:**

A groundwater source has been developed to replace Crocker Creek as the source of drinking water for the Whiskey Creek Water Service Area. Construction of temporary works to allow the use of the groundwater source will start in late April 2021 to be complete in Fall 2021. Additional funding is being sought to complete the permanent installation in 2022.
