

Upcoming Public Survey on Freshwater

The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) is conducting a randomized survey in July to learn more about community perspectives, behaviours and key priorities concerning freshwater in our region. Households will be selected at random within RDN municipalities and Electoral Areas and provided with an invitation to participate in our survey. The survey is randomized to provide a representative sample of residents across the region, including harder to reach voices.


The survey is being conducted by Ipsos, a leading public opinion research company. If you receive a phone call or postcard in the mail with a survey link, please take 10 minutes to share your thoughts with us! The survey is open until July 30, 2021. All information will be kept confidential and will only be used to help improve the RDN's water related programs in our communities.

Please note, Ipsos will not be asking survey participants any detailed personal or financial questions either over the phone or via the online survey. If you are asked for such information, the RDN's recommended course of action is to hang up and contact the RDN directly. Residents may also report suspicious activity to the RCMP or the Anti-fraud line at 1-888-495-8501.
