CURBSIDE RECYCLING

The RDN Curbside Recycling Outreach Program is currently underway and will run until the end of August. The RDN Outreach Team is inspecting recycling carts for unacceptable materials and leaving behind notices and educational material when these materials are identified. Keeping recyclables free of contamination such as plastic bags, non-recyclable plastic garbage, and scrap metal prevents recycling from ending up in landfills. It also ensures that we get the maximum value for our material from Recycle BC and helps to keep our collection costs low.

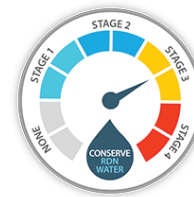

Some water service areas have elevated to Stage 3 watering restrictions for July. Veggie gardens and drip irrigation are exempt from restrictions.
