RDN and CUPE 401 Ratify a Four-Year Collective Agreement

The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) and the Canadian Union of Public Employees (CUPE), Local 401 are pleased to announce the ratification of a new, four-year collective agreement. The agreement is retroactive to January 1, 2021 and effective through to December 31, 2024. The new agreement provides for two per cent wage adjustments in each of the four years. Additional highlights of the agreement include:

- Improved benefit coverage.
- All employees and their immediate family members now have access to the Employee and Family Assistance program.
- Employees and immediate family members will have access to free bus passes.
- Scheduling efficiencies across multiple departments.

There are currently 420 members of CUPE, Local 401 working for the RDN providing a wide range of public services from North Cedar to Qualicum.
