Curbside Collection Alert for RA Routes

Curbside collection has been partially cancelled due to unsafe road conditions from snow fall today, Friday, December 24. The interruption may affect residents with curbside collection scheduled for today within the communities of Extension, Nanaimo Lakes, East Wellington and Pleasant Valley (RDN Electoral Area C), District of Lantzville, Snaw-naw-as First Nation, and Nanoose Bay (RDN Electoral Area E).

Residents are encouraged to bring their carts in from the curb to make space for snowplows. Please see below for rescheduled collection days for the impacted residents in the following communities:

- Extension and Nanaimo Lakes: Residents should ensure carts are set out for collection by 8:00 A.M. for collection on Tuesday, December 28.
- East Wellington, Pleasant Valley, Lantzville, Snaw-naw-as First Nation, and Nanoose Bay: Residents should ensure carts are set out for collection by 8:00 A.M. on Wednesday, December 29. If carts are still not emptied by 5:00 P.M. on Wednesday, please set back out again Thursday, December 30 by 8:00 A.M.

Residents receiving RDN curbside collection services are encouraged to sign up for service alert notifications by email, phone call, or the "RDN Curbside" smart phone app. Download the free "RDN Curbside" app on your Apple or Android device. Follow the instructions below to sign up for email or phone call notifications:

- Go to our website: <u>rdn.bc.ca/curbside-collection-schedules</u>
- Enter your address into the calendar search form and press search
- Select "Get a reminder!"
- Pick the type of reminder you would like to receive:
 - Weekly collection reminders and service alerts by email or phone call
 - If you do not want weekly collection reminders, you can opt to sign up for service alerts only by email
- Follow the prompts on the screen to complete the sign up
