This addendum shall be read in conjunction with and considered as an integral part of the Request for Tender. Revisions supersede the information contained in the original Tender or previously issued Addendum. No consideration will be allowed for any extras due to any Vendor not being familiar with the contents of this Addendum. All other terms and conditions remain the same.

#### **Questions & Answers**

Q1. Will the RDN be able to lower their Pollution/Environmental Impairment Liability Insurance Certificate requirements to \$2,000,000?

A1. **Delete:** "Prior to commencing work, the successful contractor will be required to provide a Pollution/Environmental Impairment Liability Insurance certificate in an amount not less than Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) per occurrence, Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) aggregate with maximum deductible of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000)."

**Replace with:** "Prior to commencing work, the successful contractor will be required to provide a Pollution/Environmental Impairment Liability Insurance certificate in an amount not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence, Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) aggregate with maximum deductible of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000)."

Q2. Can the RDN please provide if possible:

1. The undercarriage hanger details for the 8" dia. dry fire hydrant pipe under the dock;
2. The detail and location for the intake end of the pipe;
3. The detail and location for the discharge side of the pipe.

A2. The installation of the dry hydrant will be done at a later date by others. The scope of work does not include the installation of the dry hydrant or any of the components needed to attach it to the dock.

Q3. The addendum suggests that vegetation needs to be removed for 1m along the edge of both ramp and float. This may require a barge or from shore, large excavator with an extension arm to get 40 feet out into the water as the water lilies and iris are approximately that distance from the shore and within the 1 m mark you are requiring.

A3. Where possible, remove vegetation 1m from edge of ramp. Removal can be limited to what is achievable from the shore with the machinery used for the dock installation.

Q4. Can I get a copy of the bidders list?

A4. No. The RDN is not controlling a plan holder's list, so it is not available.
