Residents can complete the online survey until Friday, June 17, 2022.

"The community survey is an opportunity for residents to let us know how they feel about life in the region and what is important to them," said Tyler Brown, RDN Chair. "The information collected will provide valuable insights that will help the RDN Board of Directors develop their strategic plan for the next four years following the local government election in October."

Local Government Awareness Week is an annual initiative to build public awareness of local government roles and encourage participation in local government processes. In recognition of the week which runs until May 21, the RDN invites residents to learn about who and what the RDN is, the services provided to residents and how you can get more involved.


