
Candidates may file nomination papers with the Chief Election Officer (CEO) at the RDN Administration Office during the Nomination Period, beginning at 9 a.m. on Tuesday, August 30, 2022, and ending at 4 p.m. on Friday, September 9, 2022. Those unable to deliver nominations in person may swear the documents before a commissioner for taking affidavits in B.C. and mail, deliver, fax or email documents to the attention of the CEO by the deadline. If documents are sent by fax or email, the CEO must receive the originals by 4:30 p.m. on Friday, September 16, 2022. Nomination documents will be added to the RDN website as they are received.
