

Church Road Transfer Station - Transfer Building Repairs

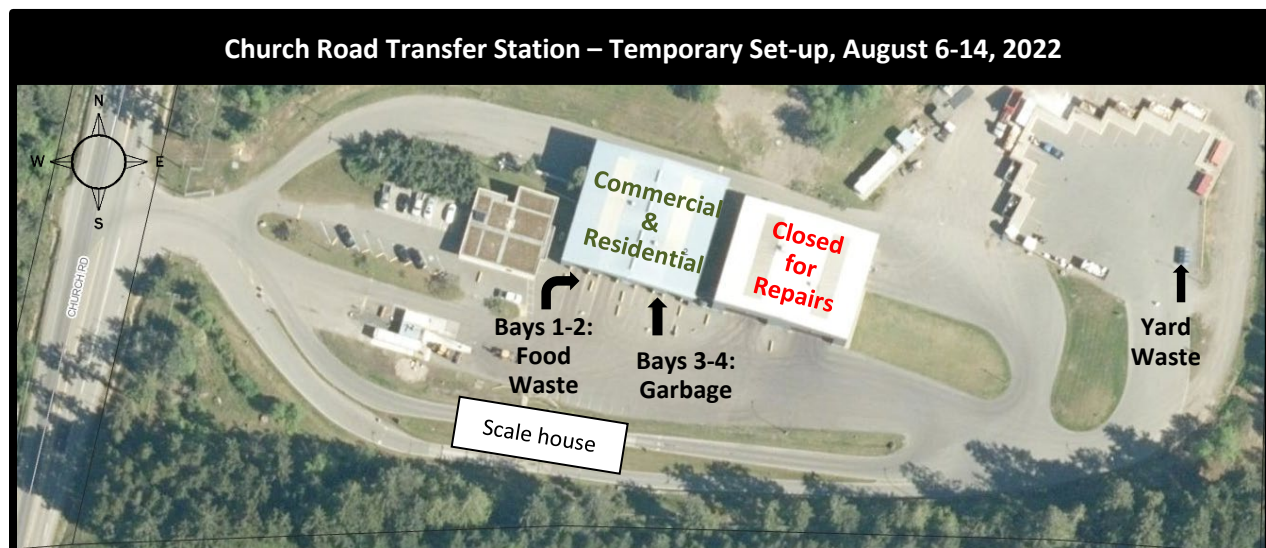
A transfer building at the Regional District of Nanaimo's (RDN) Church Road Transfer Station will be undergoing repairs from August 6 to August 14. The repairs will require a closure of the transfer building normally reserved for commercial waste haulers. During this time, all commercial and residential customers will be sharing the same transfer building and drop-off areas.

The temporary transfer building and drop-off areas from August 6 to 14 are:

- **Food waste:** Bays 1 and 2 in the west transfer building
- **Garbage:** Bays 3 and 4 in the west transfer building
- **Yard waste:** Adjacent to the Recycling Area, in the area normally used for shingle drop-off

For safety reasons, drop-off may be restricted to one vehicle per area while commercial vehicles are unloading. Please be alert to activity onsite and follow the directions of Church Road Transfer Station staff.

The transfer station sees an average of 300 to 350 vehicles per day which includes commercial, residential curbside and residential customers. Processing times will increase during peak hours while repairs are underway. We appreciate your patience.
