

FRENCH CREEK
ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PLAN

PURPOSE OF THE BYLAW

The purpose of the bylaw is to incorporate policies and mapping from the French Creek Active Transportation Plan into the Electoral Area 'G' Official Community Plan (OCP). Active transportation includes all human-powered forms of travel, including walking, cycling, inline skating, and skateboarding, as well as complimentary electric forms of travel such as electric bikes and mobility scooters. The OCP amendment policies and mapping include the active transportation network, facility standards and implementation items established in the French Creek Active Transportation Plan. The policies will guide the RDN in establishing a safer, more accessible active transportation network in the French Creek area (the area shown on the map).

HAVE YOUR SAY

All persons who consider their interest in their property to be affected by the proposed bylaw shall be afforded an opportunity to be heard in person or by written submission at the public hearing. Written submissions may be submitted in advance of the public hearing and must be received at the RDN office by **4:30 p.m. Tuesday, November 22, 2022,** to ensure their inclusion in the public record. Written submissions may be submitted by email to *planning@rdn.bc.ca* or by mail or in person to 6300 Hammond Bay Road, Nanaimo, B.C., V9T 6N2.
