RDN Board Approves Grants in Support of Local Organizations

The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) Board approved grants for 15 organizations across the region at the December 6, 2022, board meeting. The value of the grants awarded totals \$32,200 and will be used for a variety of community and recreation focused projects.

The grants were awarded through three programs: Oceanside Recreation Services Youth Grants, Oceanside Recreation Services Community Grants and Oceanside Community Safety Grants. Recreation grants support recreation programs, special events or projects which benefit specific communities in the Oceanside area. Safety grants support programs and services that help increase safety in the community. The funding was allocated as follows:

Oceanside Community Safety Grants: \$3,500 total awarded


