

JOB SUMMARY

The Maintenance Worker contributes to the effective operation of the Recreation Department through the maintenance, cleaning, and preparation of facility ice. This position supports the Recreation Department by assisting team members in their duties, as required, to meet service expectations, departmental goals, and objectives.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for Oceanside Place building security.
- Inspects and cleans all areas of Oceanside Place on a routine basis.
- Assists Maintenance Supervisor in routine maintenance of the Oceanside Place ice plant and ice making equipment
 including the routine maintenance of the Zamboni.
- Operates the Zamboni including inspection and maintenance of a quality ice surface.
- Maintains Arena exterior, grounds, and signage.
- Assists in facility set-up for user group activities.
- Performs Arena operating procedures in a safe manner.
- Performs other related duties, as required.
