2023 HOME UPGRADE REBATES

As part of the RDN's action on climate change and environmental stewardship, rebates are available for climate-friendly home upgrades, with new and higher amounts for installing a heat pump.

- Upgrade to climate friendly heating \$400 to \$1,000
- Sustainable Development Checklist \$500 or \$1,000
- Home Energy Assessments up to \$350
- Renewable Energy Systems \$250
- Oil to Heat Pump \$250
- Residential EV Charging Station \$150
- Graded Site-Cut Timber \$250

NEW – COMMUNITY WOOD SMOKE REDUCTION PROGRAM

The Community Wood Smoke Reduction Program (formerly the Woodstove Exchange Program) is running again in 2023, with exciting program changes and increased rebate amounts.

Increased Incentives

RDN residents getting rid of their old smoky wood stoves and buying a new EPA/CSA certified electric insert, wood stove or pellet stove are eligible for rebates between \$400 and \$750.

New Heat Pump Rebates

RDN residents who buy and install a qualified heat pump and dispose of an old wood stove may be eligible for a rebate of \$1,000.

NEW PILOT Rebate! Get a Heat Pump AND Keep Your Woodstove

RDN electoral area residents who currently use a certified wood stove for home heating can keep their old wood stove for emergency heating and still qualify for a \$1,000 rebate on a new, qualifying heat pump. Conditions apply.

2023 WATER STEWARDSHIP REBATES OPEN!

Rainwater Harvesting

Thinking about installing some rainwater catchment on your property? Eligible RDN residents can receive up to \$750 for the installation or addition of 1,000 imperial gallons or more of rainwater storage.

Irrigation Upgrades and Soil Improvements

Make your property more water efficient! Eligible RDN residents can receive up to \$475 for irrigation upgrades and/or 50 per cent off garden soil improvements up to \$100. Receive a \$100 bonus rebate for completing both irrigation and soil upgrades.



Wellhead Upgrades and Well Water Testing

Proper maintenance is important for the longevity of your private well and quality of your drinking water. Eligible RDN residents can receive up to \$650 for wellhead upgrades and 50 per cent off up to \$175 for well water testing.
