Questions and Answers

1. Q. Does the RDN require a Cadastral Composite Plan, based on existing legal plans, and found legal evidence?
A. No. The City of Nanaimo has a reliable Cadastral Composite Plan.
2. Q. Would the District allow the use of other underground utility locate tools, or is GPR mandatory?
A. For the purpose of this RFP, in order compare like proposals, GPR is mandatory. The RDN will consider other tools that may be recommended by the selected proponent.
3. Q. Does the RDN require consultant to submit a Utility Locate Report for this project?
A. No.
4. Q. Is it possible to do a lane shutdown to complete the GPR work, and if so, during what time of day?
