Questions & Answers

- Q1. Are you able to advise if the bins for the RDN would be being dumped on your accounts at the processors or would you be looking for us to choose the processors? Do you have specific recycling processors you currently have the bins hauled to?
- A1. The tender is for hauling and bin rental only. All recycling facilities will be under RDN account at the following locations with the RDN responsible for any fee payments:
 - a) Card board, Multi bin (plastic/tin) and paper Cascades Recovery 800 Maughan Road, Nanaimo
 - b) Wood Regional Landfill, 1105 Cedar Road, Nanaimo
 - c) Recyclable Gypsum GFL, 2250 McGarrigle Road, Nanaimo
 - d) ACM Gypsum Regional Landfill, 1105 Cedar Road, Nanaimo

These are the current locations of recyclers. The RDN is not contractually bound to these recyclers. The locations and vendors of recyclers could change at any time. The RDN and successful contractor may agree to amend the existing agreement should any changes occur.

- Q2. Where are we to indicate the cost for the processing as its listed as bin haul but processing would normally be charges per tonne in addition to the hauling?
- A2. Pricing for this requirement has been deleted. Please refer to the Revised Tender Form attached herein.

Subsequent annual increases for contract years 3, 4, & 5 may be based on the BC All-Items CPI index subject to final negotiations and mutual written agreement between the parties. Year 3 increase will be based on the Year 2 rates. Year 4 increase based on Year 3 rates. Year 5 increase based on Year 4 rates

Any Service Fee increases may be adjusted an annual basis every July 1st beginning in Year 3 based on the percent change in the BC CPI for the past 12 months from December to December. The CPI referenced is the "All Items" index of BC as published by Statistics Canada (https://www150.statcan.gc.ca/t1/tbl1/en/tv.action?pid=1810000401).

Anticipated contract start date is July 1, 2023.
