No consideration will be allowed for any extras due to any Proponent not being familiar with the contents of this Addendum. All other terms and conditions remain the same.

Questions and Answers:

This following is a compilation of questions received from possible Proponents from September 1, at 12 pm, and the answers to these questions.

- Q1. We are interested in bidding on this project however need clarification on the bid. It states we must be able to pump 3000 gallons per trip. If we are awarded the contract, we would purchase a larger truck to handle that volume. Until that truck arrives, would we be permitted to perform two trips to haul that amount each time? This would still be at the same price we put into the bid but want to know if that would be permitted.
- **A1.** No, due to pumping at NBPCC it is required to have only one truck do the pump out and perform only one trip to FCPCC. The truck must be able to carry 3,000 gallons.
