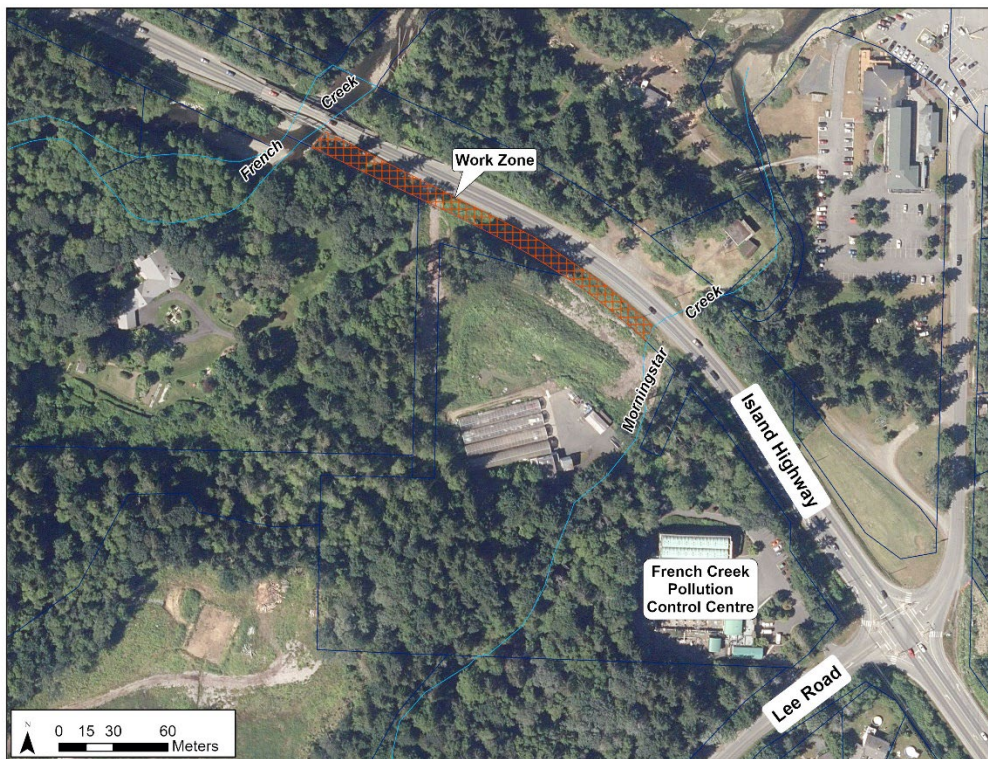


Highway Access Construction



On March 17, 2025, construction of a new highway access will begin in the work zone, as shown in the image below, and is expected to take approximately one month. Slow-moving trucks will be entering and exiting the highway. Pedestrians and cyclists may experience minor delays.

For your safety, please exercise caution when travelling through the work zone, obey signage and directions from the site crew and do not enter work areas. Access to the construction site is prohibited unless authorized by the site supervisor.



The new highway access is needed for the French Creek Pollution Control Centre Expansion and Odour Control Upgrade Project.
