NEW WASTE DIVERSION BYLAW IN EFFECT

New waste diversion rules are in effect for all commercial, institutional, industrial and multifamily buildings as of January 1, 2025. The Mandatory Waste Source Separation (MWSS) Bylaw will work in conjunction with the Waste Hauler Licensing (WHL) Bylaw to divert recycling and organics away from the landfill. All multifamily residences and businesses will be required to have separate bins for garbage, recycling, and food waste that reside in:

- Nanaimo Lantzville Parksville
- Qualicum Beach and; RDN Electoral Areas

WATERING RESTRICTIONS

Stage 2 Watering Restrictions for automated sprinkling systems begin on May 1. This allows even or odd day watering based on house numbers for a maximum of two hours between 7 and 10 a.m. or 7 and 10 p.m.

Note: the Town of Qualicum Beach starts Stage 1 restrictions May 15, Deep Bay Improvement District and Qualicum Bay Horne Lake Waterworks

currently have no restrictions, and Decourcey and Surfside RDN systems remains at stage 4 restrictions. To learn more, visit:
