

Job Summary

The Aquatic Maintenance Worker contributes to the effective operation of the Recreation Department through the maintenance, cleaning and preparation of the Ravensong Aquatic Centre (RAC). This position supports the Recreation Department by assisting team members in their duties, as required, to meet service expectations, departmental goals and objectives.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

- Inspects and cleans all areas of the RAC on a routine basis and maintains the Aquatic Centre's exterior, grounds and signage.
- Responsible for RAC building security.
- Assists Aquatic Facilities Operator in routine maintenance of RAC operating systems and equipment.
- Performs routine water quality tests.
- Performs water treatment as required.
- Performs carpentry, painting, tile, plumbing and pump repairs as required.
- Assists in facility set-up for user group activities.
- Performs RAC operating procedures in a safe manner.
- Reviews, adheres to, and supports the adherence to safe work procedures in the workplace and generally promotes a safe work environment.
