**The Stevie Smith Legacy Foundation is Developing a New Pump Track in Cedar**

The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) is pleased to announce that the Cedar Community will be getting a new pump track through a generous donation from the Stevie Smith Legacy Foundation. The Foundation will fund the design and installation of the pump track which will be located beside the Cedar Skate Park on Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools District land. The RDN holds an agreement with School District 68 to manage this property through a License of Use agreement.

A preliminary concept plan has been created to show how the pump track could be integrated within the School District property which will also include a children's playground. Over the coming months, the concept will be further refined to create a final design. Construction of the pump track, by the Foundation, is anticipated to start in 2026.

The RDN will manage and maintain the pump track after it has been constructed. These costs will be funded through the Electoral Area A Community Parks and Halls operating budget.
