HEAT PREPAREDNESS

Did you know? There are two categories of heat events.

- 1. Heat Warning: means that temperatures are very hot and there is a moderate public health risk. A heat warning will usually be issued one to three times in a typical summer.
- Extreme Heat: means that temperatures are dangerous and there is a very high public health risk. An extreme heat emergency may only be issued one to two times per decade.

Have a plan to keep you cool and safe! It is important to evaluate whether you can safely stay in your home during an extreme heat emergency (prolonged exposure to temperatures over 31°C is dangerous for vulnerable people). For more information, visit www.rdn.bc.ca/extreme-weather or

- Residential EV Charging Station: \$150

All rebates are first-come, first-serve for qualifying applicants and can be stacked with provincial rebate offers.
