Impact of the Canada Post Strike on the Nanaimo River Fire Protection Area - Fire Truck Storage Facility Construction Survey 2025

As of September 25, 2025, Canada Post workers went on strike, impacting nation-wide service delivery. Per Canada Post's update, mail and parcels will not be processed or delivered for the duration of the national strike, and some post offices will be closed. Service guarantees are suspended for items already in the postal network.

Due to the current postal strike, mail delivery is not an option for returning a completed Nanaimo River Fire Protection Area - Fire Truck Storage Facility Construction survey by the deadline of October 6, 2025.

While a postage-paid envelope was sent to eligible survey respondents, we strongly encourage you to use one of the following alternative methods to ensure your survey is received by the deadline:
