Watering Restrictions Downgraded to Stage 2 for Most RDN Water Service Areas

Watering restrictions have been downgraded to Stage 2 in Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) Water Service Areas except for the Nanoose Bay Peninsula, Decourcey and Surfside Water Service Areas which will remain at Stage 4 due to operational needs.

Recent rain events have relieved drought conditions and reduced the seasonal water demand in our communities. Many stream flows are returning to normal levels for this time of year.

Conserving water, however, is an important, year-round habit as drought conditions are coming earlier and lasting longer than in the past. Increasing our water efficiency helps build drought-resilience over the long term. We thank residents for doing their part!
