## Water Stewardship Rebates

Thank you to everyone who saved water through our 2025 rebates! These rebates reopen again in early 2026:

**Rainwater Harvesting:** Eligible RDN residents can get up to \$1,000 for the installation or addition of 1,000 imperial gallons of rainwater storage.

**Irrigation Upgrades and Soil Improvements:** Eligible RDN residents can get up to \$875 for irrigation upgrades and/or 50 per cent off garden soil improvements up to \$100. Get a \$100 bonus rebate for completing both irrigation and soil upgrades.

**Wellhead Upgrades and Well Water Testing:** Eligible RDN residents can get up to \$650 for wellhead upgrades or up to \$500 for the closure of any unused well. In addition, 50 per cent off (up to \$300) a full spectrum water quality analysis is available to RDN private well-owners.

Looking to upgrade your home before the year wraps up? The RDN offers rebates to make your home more comfortable and climate-resilient this winter. Warm up your space and lower your energy bills with options like:

- Upgrade to Climate-Friendly Heating: up to \$1,500
- Sustainable Development Checklist: up to \$1,000
- Fossil Fuel to Heat Pump: \$1,000
- Home Energy Assessments: up to \$350
- Renewable Energy Systems: up to \$400
- Graded Site-Cut Timber: \$250
- Residential EV Charging Station: \$150

All rebates are first-come, first-serve for qualifying applicants and can be stacked with provincial rebate offers.

**Community Wood Smoke Reduction Program:** Do you have an old, smoky woodstove? Improve the air quality in your home and your community by replacing your uncertified stove with a cleaner, more efficient heating system. When you upgrade, you may qualify for rebates through the Community Woodsmoke Reduction Program:

- \$400 for an Electric Insert
- \$600 for a Certified Wood Stove
- \$1,000 for a Certified Pellet Stove
- \$1,500 for an Electric Heat Pump
