#### **Questions & Answers**

**Q1.** I see that there is an addendum that adds some great additional information/amendment to the expectations of the bid. We are seeking a little more guidance when it comes to budgeted amount. I just want to double-check that the maximum allowable budget for the project is CA \$70,000 not including GST, as listed in the Jan 15th addendum. I see that this is clarified in the addendum; however, it was listed in the original project document (Schedule A) for an all-inclusive rate or total not surpassing inclusive of GST.

**A1.** The project has a maximum budget of **\$70,000 & GST**. It is not funded through grant programs, including the BC Climate Resilience Investment Program. The Regional District's Consultant Services Agreement Schedule A is just a sample/draft document at this time and will be updated as necessary with the successful proponent.

**Q2.** In the 2022 Parks and Trails Strategy document under section 6; goal 4.3 it mentions a budget of \$50,000 for the development of a wildfire and risk assessment strategy plan. It also mentions a \$3,570 per electoral area. Is the \$3,570 an addition to the \$50,000 budget? We are currently working on a bid submission and reviewing applicable documentation to quantify the amount of work required to meet the deliverables.

**A2.** The project has a maximum budget of \$70,000 & GST. Please disregard the values in the 2022 Parks and Trails Strategy document.
