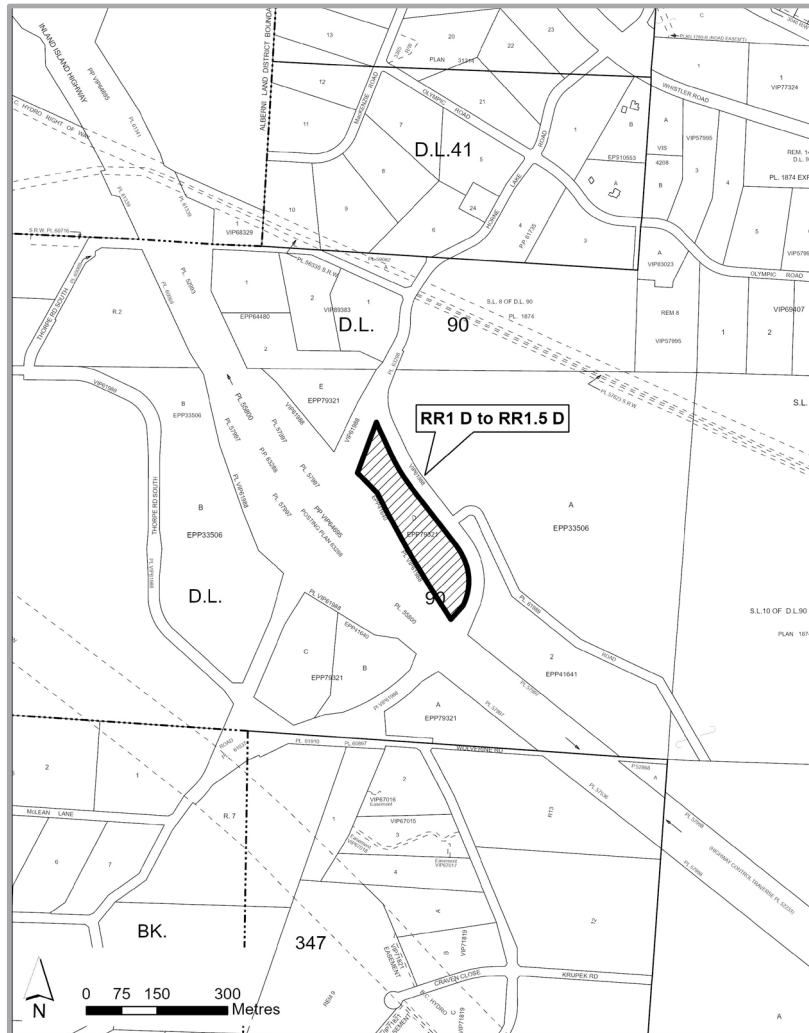


The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) is in receipt of a zoning amendment application for the property shown in the location map below.

## NOTICE OF ZONING AMENDMENT

### PURPOSE OF PROPOSED BYLAW

The applicant proposes to rezone the subject property from Rural Residential 1 (RR1) Zone, Subdivision District 'D', to the proposed Rural Residential 1.5 (RR1.5) sub zone, Subdivision District 'D' under "Regional District of Nanaimo Zoning Bylaw No. 2500, 2024". This amendment is intended to facilitate a new residential-commercial development. The applicant's intention is to build a new single-family dwelling and expand the accessory uses permitted on the property to develop a mini storage facility; boat and recreational vehicle storage; and an accessory boat and recreational vehicle repair and service shop and office.
