

New Pump Track Open to the Public in Lions Community Park

The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) is pleased to announce that the new pump track in Lions Community Park is open for public use. All ages and abilities are welcome at the pump track which is the RDN's first paved track. The design accommodates beginner and intermediate riders, and the asphalt surface increases durability, extends the riding season and creates a smooth, consistent riding experience for all users.

The pump track was identified as a priority improvement during the Lions Community Park master planning process (2021-2022) and was included in phase 2 of the project. The cost to install the pump track was \$35,000 using budgeted phase 2 funds. Lions Community Park is a 14-acre park located near Qualicum Bay in Electoral Area H (Bowser, Qualicum Bay, Deep Bay).
