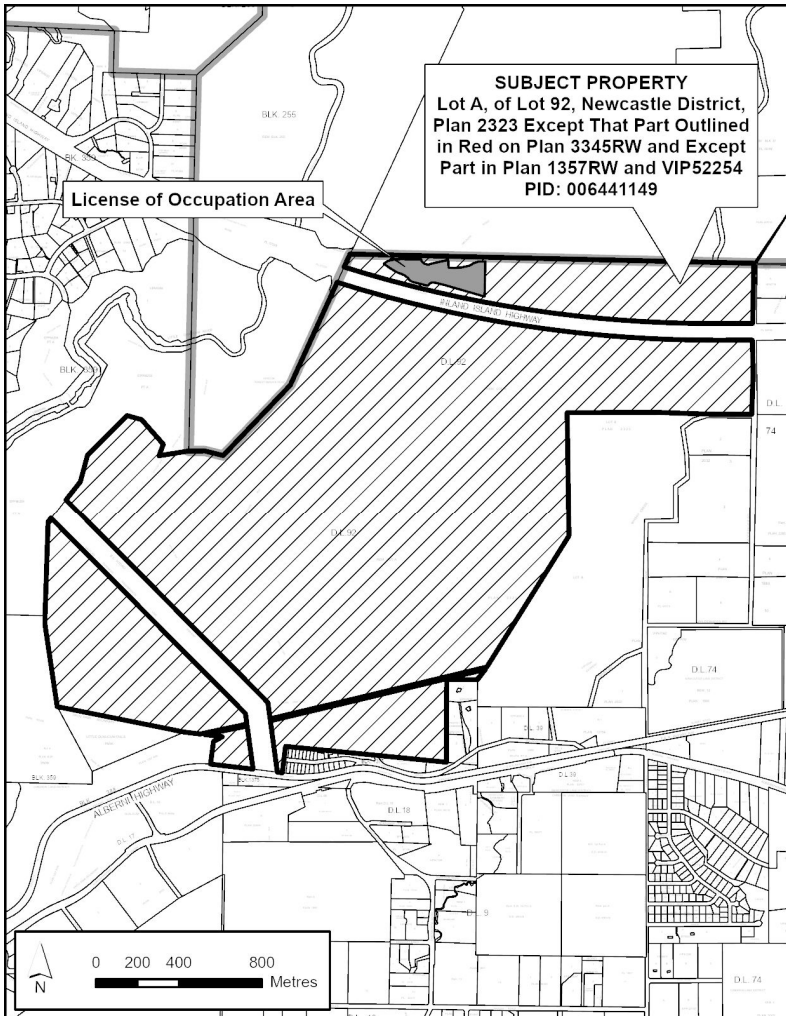


The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) is in receipt of a Temporary Use Permit Renewal Application for the property shown in the location map below.

PURPOSE OF APPLICATION

The RDN has received an application to renew a Temporary Use Permit (TUP) to continue operating an ATV practice and training facility, along with accessory campground use on the subject property for a period of three (3) years (see Attachment 1 –Site Plan). A TUP for this use was previously issued by the RDN in 2023 and is set to expire in October 2026. The applicant is requesting a renewal to allow the use to continue for an additional three-year term. The area proposed for the use is identified as the License of Occupation area on the location map to the left.
