



Pre-approval Application: 2022 Wellhead Upgrades Rebate

The RDN is offering rebates of up to \$650 to help residents upgrade their private domestic wellhead. In 2005 the Province of BC introduced new best practices for wellhead construction to better protect ground-water quality. Rebates to bring wellheads up to current standards are available until December 15, 2022 or until funds are exhausted. Apply for pre-approval to “reserve” funds for eligible work for up to 90 days. If you qualify for the rebate, an approval letter will be sent to you. A complete list of program requirements is available online at www.RDNrebates.ca and on the Wellhead Upgrades Rebate Information sheet.

2. REBATE REQUEST:

I am applying for pre-approval for the following eligible upgrade(s):

- Secure well cap – maximum rebate \$50 for drilled wells; maximum rebate \$150 for dug wells
- Well casing stick-up extension – maximum rebate \$200
- Underground surface seal – maximum rebate \$300
- Closure of an unused well (can't be combined with any of the above upgrades) – maximum rebate \$500

3. UPGRADE DETAILS:

Description of upgrade(s) to be performed to bring wellhead up to Provincial Best Practices, see BCGWA handbook for details (www.bcgwa.org/Handbook). Description must correspond to photograph(s) demonstrating the current state of well that requires upgrades.

I am submitting **photo(s)** of the wellhead requiring upgrade(s) at the address above, clearly demonstrating deficiencies of any of the components described above.

Acknowledgement: I understand that I am not pre-approved until I receive my confirmation letter. Pre-approval expires 90 days after the confirmation letter is issued. Contact RDN to request an extension.
