

EVACUATION ORDER RESCINDED

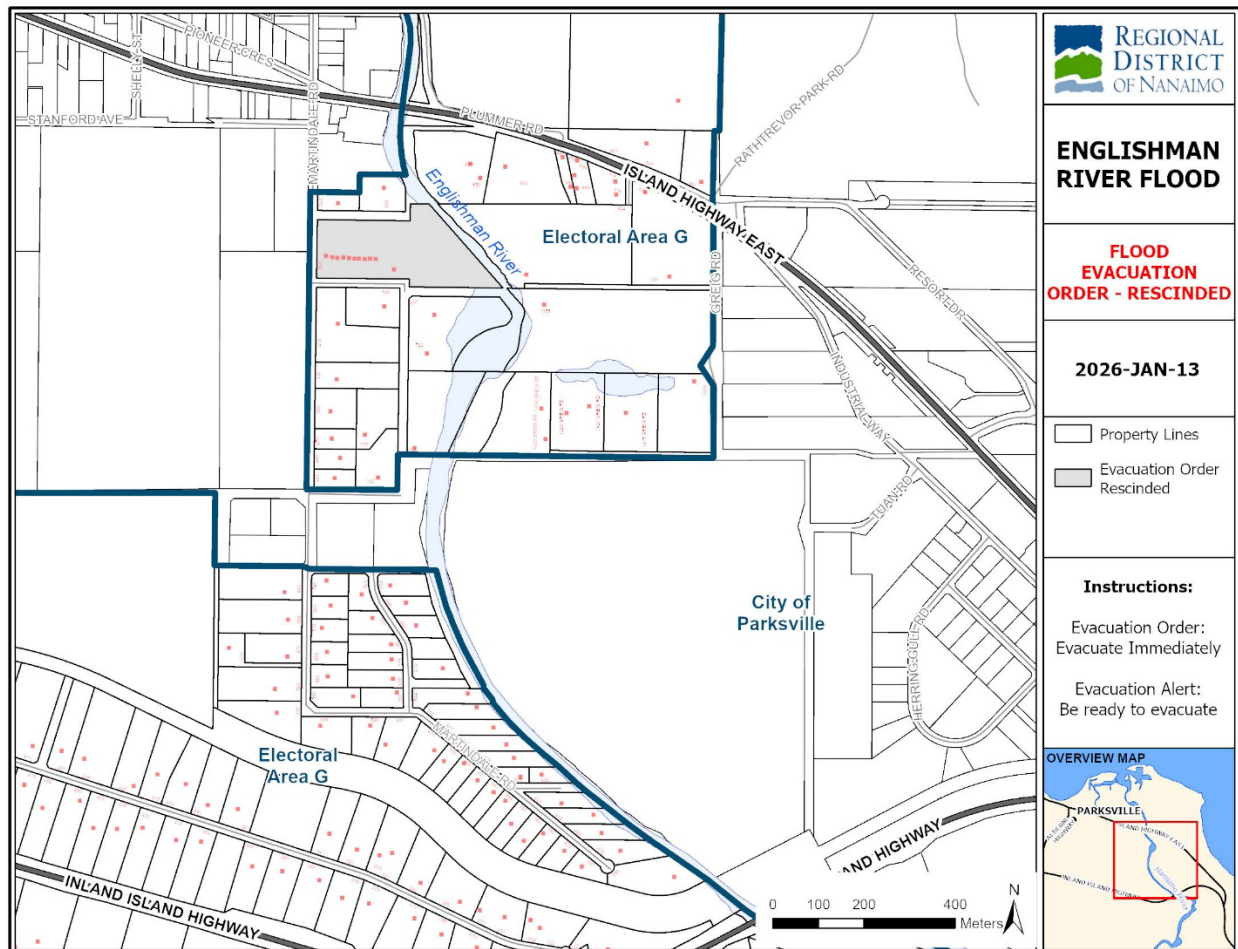
Englishman River Flooding

Date: **January 13, 2026** Time: **1230 hrs**

The Evacuation Order, pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the BC *Emergency Disaster and Management Act* issued **January 12, 2026, 1100 hrs**, by the **Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN)** has been rescinded.

The Evacuation Order is rescinded for **380 Martindale Road**.

MAP OF AREA:




An Evacuation Order may need to be re-issued; however, if that is deemed necessary, the Evacuation Order process will re-commence.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

After floodwaters have receded there are important steps that must be taken:

- Getting authorized technicians to assess any electrical or gas equipment exposed to floodwaters.
- Getting your power or gas turned back on if required.
- Ensuring your home and contents are properly cleaned before moving back in.
- Confirming a supply of safe water is available.
- Arranging for the proper disposal of human waste and garbage.
